Part-Time Study Information

Part-time status is ordinarily approved for the following reasons:

1. having to care for small children at home
2. personal ill health
3. severe illness of other family members
4. extreme financial strain in cases in which the student has dependents.

In addition, the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences has provision for a limited number of students who are admitted to the Master of Science program to study on a part-time basis.

Part-time students are subject to the same requirements and regulations as full-time students. A part-time student who is taking less than three courses may complete a Harvard University Health Services waiver request to waive both the student health fee and the Blue Cross Blue Shield fee (visit www.huhs.harvard.edu for online waiver and information).

Foreign nationals with student visas who are not permanent residents of the United States may only register for part-time study if they are in their last term and have three or fewer courses remaining to complete their program. International students must have their part-time petitions signed by the Harvard International Office.
